Fishing

- Pants:** fleece or something warm
- Sweater:** fleece, wool
- Socks**
- Hat**
- Gloves**
- Sunglasses** (preferably polarizing)
- Reusable water bottle**
- Camera and chargers**

At the lodge

- Casual pants and shirts**
- Light sweater for evening**
- Windbreaker**
- Shorts/swimsuit for hot tub**
- Walking shoes**
- Prescription medication**
- Toiletries including lip balm**

ON THE BOAT

Top of the line rain gear and rubber boots are provided for your comfort out on the water. Our suits provide an excellent barrier from the rain and wind but are light weight, so it is important to pack additional layers for underneath to be prepared for all weather conditions.

Available on all boats: Sunscreen and seasickness remedies (Gravol and wristbands) but feel free to bring what works for you.

SIZING INFO



Don't forget to fill out the trip information forms with your sizes **before your arrival** so everything will be set and ready to go.

PACKING ADVICE

The weather out here can be unpredictable. On average, the temperature can range from 11-17°C or 52-62°F. **Think dressing in layers.**

Our lodge is well equipped with several items in case you forget to pack anything. From toiletries, sundry items to clothing in our gift shop.

We must limit luggage to a **maximum of 30lbs.** Most guests find it accommodates what they need to bring.

DO NOT BRING

- Alcohol, bug spray, hair dryers or towels
- Raingear and boots, fishing equipment
